Consens publishes a manifesto to support Carine Montaner

The party defends «the three pillars of democracy»

The Consens political party published a statement last Sunday in which it expressed its support «to General Counsel Carine Montaner in the face of the Prosecutor's request for two years of conditional imprisonment and her disqualification for two years for a major crime of revelation of secrets for having made public the salary of the former General Counsel and current Ambassador of Andorra to the United Nations in Geneva, Switzerland and Lichtenstein, Ferran Costa». In this way, Consens took a position in favor of the leader of Andorra Endavant (AE) because the group believes that a necessary reflection must be made «in light of the latest political and judicial events», because «Andorran society has a lot to lose and probably has already lost a lot.» However, the political formation exposed, th-

rough the missive, that «prosecuting a general councilor [...] seems very dangerous to us in a democracy». On the other hand, the manifesto also pointed to the confidence that the political group maintains in «the pillars of democracy», which they defined in the text as three: «The legislative power, the executive and the judicial». Finally, Consens emphasized the fact that it does not think that Montaner's case is a political persecution: «We do not want to think in any case that it could be a political persecution».

ADJRA promotes digital well-being with the campaign 'Life is not in pixels: Wake up'

The Association for the Defense of Youth at Risk of Andorra (AD-JRA), with the collaboration of the Andorran Red Cross, Heracles Group and Andorran Family Business, launched an innovative campaign entitled «Life is not in pixels: Wake up». This project seeks to encourage a conscious and balanced use of digital devices, sending three different messages aimed at families with children and young people through the distribution of coasters that will be distributed in different restaurant establishments throughout the country. The three key messages of the campaign are 'Disconnect to reconnect with yourself', as a reminder that life cannot be reduced to pixels and the encouragement to take conscious breaks from the digital world to connect with real experiences; 'Don't underestimate the danger, your and finally 'Life is not in pixels, wake up': A call to value authentic human experiences that cannot be replicated or reduced to a screen. The initiative highlights the importance of a healthy balance between the digital and real worlds. At a time when technology is ubiquitous, actions like these serve to remind us that outside our screens there is a whole world waiting to be explored, and a life to be connected with real experiences.

The profile of the people treated at the SAD: widowed women aged between 85 and 89

The organization serves a total of 135 people during the month of January

The home care service (SAD) currently serves over a hundred people. Thus, according to the data provided by the Ministry of Social Affairs, 135 people were treated at the end of January. With regard to the majority profiles of these users, we should highlight widowed women between the ages of 85 and 89 who live alone and who have autonomy difficulties or who need support for the basic activities of daily life. If the state of health of these people is taken into account, it should be noted that the most common are frail patients followed by people with dementia. To meet the needs of these users, the service currently has a workforce of 21

people. From the ministry, they emphasize the fact that the mission of the SAD professional is to enhance the autonomy of the people and families served, «with a diagnostic, assistance, educational, rehabilitative and socializing action, to maintain and improve the autonomy and relationship with the environment, carrying out monitoring and care in the health, psychological and social aspects, through individual home care plans (PAID)". In this way, what is intended is to favor «an alter-

The people served are mostly widowed women aged between 85 and 89 who live alone and need support native model to hospitalization or residential admission, achieving more efficiency of the socio-health system and responding to the needs of citizens».

In this sense, they reiterate that the intention is to strengthen attention to the elderly and to people with dependency, autonomy difficulties or who need support to carry out day-today activities, getting them to remain at home as much as possible time «always with quality and personalized attention».

And beyond the support work they carry out, it is also emphasized that the SAD team of professionals advises users and families on other complementary services that may be available to them. And, precisely, from the area of Socio-sanitary Services of the Ministry of Social Affairs, on which the SAD depends, the homes are adapted with the support products of the bank of technical aids to promote the maximum autonomy of the person, as reported by the ANA.
