Emergency services conduct the first simulation earthquake in the country

The purpose of the action is to make all possible mistakes so as not to repeat them in a real case

The exercise pretends that a magnitude 5.8 earthquake has affected different parts of the country

he country's emergency services, together with the collaboration of the Government, carried out a drill in the event of an earthquake last Monday, with the aim of testing the Action Plan for seismic emergencies. This is the first time that a drill has been conducted in the country, but the head of the Fire Brigade, Marc Rogé, said that «the demolition group has been involved in national maneuvers in the south of France since of the year 2008 «and in this sense, he added that» we have not proposed this action for fear of this year's seismic period, but to see how we develop with the knowledge we already have».

Forty firefighters and about 65 more from other services have been mobilized

The exercise consisted of pretending that a magnitude 5.8 earthquake had caused damage in different parts of Sant Julià de Lòria and Andorra la Vella, and began when the director of the Fire Brigade, Jordi Farré, received the first call at 08.59 in the morning by Andorra Research and Innovation (ARI). Later, other announcements from different sectors were added that were destroyed due to the natural disaster, and a helicopter flight was run to see what the impact was on the different areas and thus assess which were the highest priority. The fire station housed the main stage, which simulated the demolition of a two-story building, in which six people lived and where there were also two workers performing maintenance and intervention work on the tower of voltage located next to the house. The teams that took part were the Fire Brigade, the dog unit teams, the demolition unit, the mountain rescue group, some nurses, the Civil Protection, the ARI, the Red Cross, the Police Forc and the COEX, to intervene in the fictitious victims and adapt the affected space. Firefighters also created a special agreement with archi-

tects and engineers to evaluate the damaged structures. In addition, the Hotel Union of Andorra (UHA) and Authentic Hotels of Andorra (AHA) intervened in the aspect of the alleged rehousing of the victims. On the other hand, the Union of Amateur Radio Amateurs (URA) verified the communications to establish them in analog format. In total, about 40 firefighters and approximately 65 were involved in the rest of the services. «These plans include a series of operational deployments in the rear and from Civil Protection, for exam-



ple, we have been part of the technical committee together with the Fire Brigade and the ARI», said the director of Civil Protection, Cristian Pons.

The main purpose of the action was to make all possible mistakes so as not to repeat them in a possible real case. Regarding the drill, the Minister of Justice and Home Affairs, Josep Maria Rossell, stated that «recently, some seismic phenomena have occurred in the Principality, and about a year and a half ago the possibility of creating a Plan of action in case there were any". Regarding the simulation, he added that «we also have the Civil Protection Act in parliamentary proceedings and, therefore, we thought it appropriate to move forward with the action plans that must be made once the law is approved.» Finally, Farré emphasized that «today we value coordination and collaboration between the different bodies in the country, as this is the first time we have worked together». For now, the goal is to keep running the action year after year. \equiv

-Does it take a period of mourning to move on?

-It would be recommended, but the question is that I don't know if we have this time. Right now, I think the people who support us are pulling me closer than anything else. That's how I feel, I'm the one most responsible and that invites us to get to work as soon as possible to give back all the support that the people around the club are giving us. We must give them back their confidence, that this mourning is as short as possible to try to make the best possible project to rise again.

-You were part of the ascent eight years ago. How is the contrast experienced with a descent?

-It's a new situation. When we ascended we came from very low, with ambition, with desire, and now we return to the LEB taking a step back. We will have to find that ambition again, and coming back should be the main factor that motivates you.
