## The magic of the Three Kings fills the streets of the Principality

This January 5th, the parishes of Andorra celebrated the traditional cavalcades of the Three Kings, offering a show of magic, tradition and proximity. The events were starred by Their Majesties Melchior, Gaspar and Baltasar, who brought excitement to children and families in every corner of the country.

**Andorra la Vella and Escaldes-Engordany: a massive joint cavalcade**

Andorra la Vella and Escaldes-Engordany organized a joint caval-

cade that began at 6:00 p.m. from the Plaça dels Dos Valires in Escaldes-Engordany, traveling along the commercial axis to the Plaça del Poble in Andorra la Vella. The cavalcade was attended by nearly 500 people and 18 floats decorated with themes from children's imagination, including characters from cinema and literature.

During the route, up to 7,000 kilograms of candy were distributed, filling the streets full of families and visitors with sweetness and joy. Upon arriving at Plaça del Poble, the Royal Palace was set up, where Their Majesties personally received the children, listening to their wishes and co-

llecting their letters.

**La Massana: a celebration focused on proximity and fun**

La Massana turned Plaça de l'Església into the central point of the festivities. The Three Kings rode on horseback through the central streets of the town, culminating in the Estelàrium children's activity park. This space welcomed hundreds of families who shared moments with Their Majesties, in a show of proximity that characterized the celebration.

In addition to the traditional sweets, the children received a voucher to eat at the Estelàrium food trucks, with options such as pizza, chips and popcorn. The park, which offered activities such as horse-drawn carriages, an urban forest and a climbing wall, closed its doors until the next Christmas season.

**Encamp: shows, music and tradition**

In Encamp, the cavalcade started promptly at 6:00 pm from the roundabout of the old cable car, with a route that passed through Avinguda Joan Martí to Plaça dels Arinsols. The parade stood out for its cultural and artistic involvement, with a performance by the Club Esportiu Andorrà de dansa i fitness and the travelling show 'Crazy Ors', by the company Mademoiselle Paillote. Upon arriving at the square, the Three Kings personally collec-

ted the children's letters in an atmosphere of great anticipation.

In Pas de la Casa, the activities began with a spectacular descent of Their Majesties down the ski slopes with retractors and torches. Fireworks ended the calvacade, which continued through the streets to the Sala de Festes, where the Kings received the little ones. In both towns, cake and chocolates were distributed to complete the celebration.

#### Ordino: culture and tradition in the town center

In Ordino, the Three Kings arrived at the Andorra Congress Centre at 7pm. The children of the parish performed the Pastorets in front of the Kings, a tradition that moved the audience. At the end, the consul general, Maria del Mar Coma, gave the Kings the key to all the Ordino homes so that they could distribute the gifts during the night. The evening was completed with the distribution of cake and chocolate, in an atmosphere that combined tradition and coexistence.

#### Canillo: magic in the heart of the parish

In Canillo, the cavalcade took place between the Perecaus building and the Canillo Brilla site, located in the old Pla campsite. The consul general, Jordi Alcobé, officially received Their Majesties, who collected the letters from
