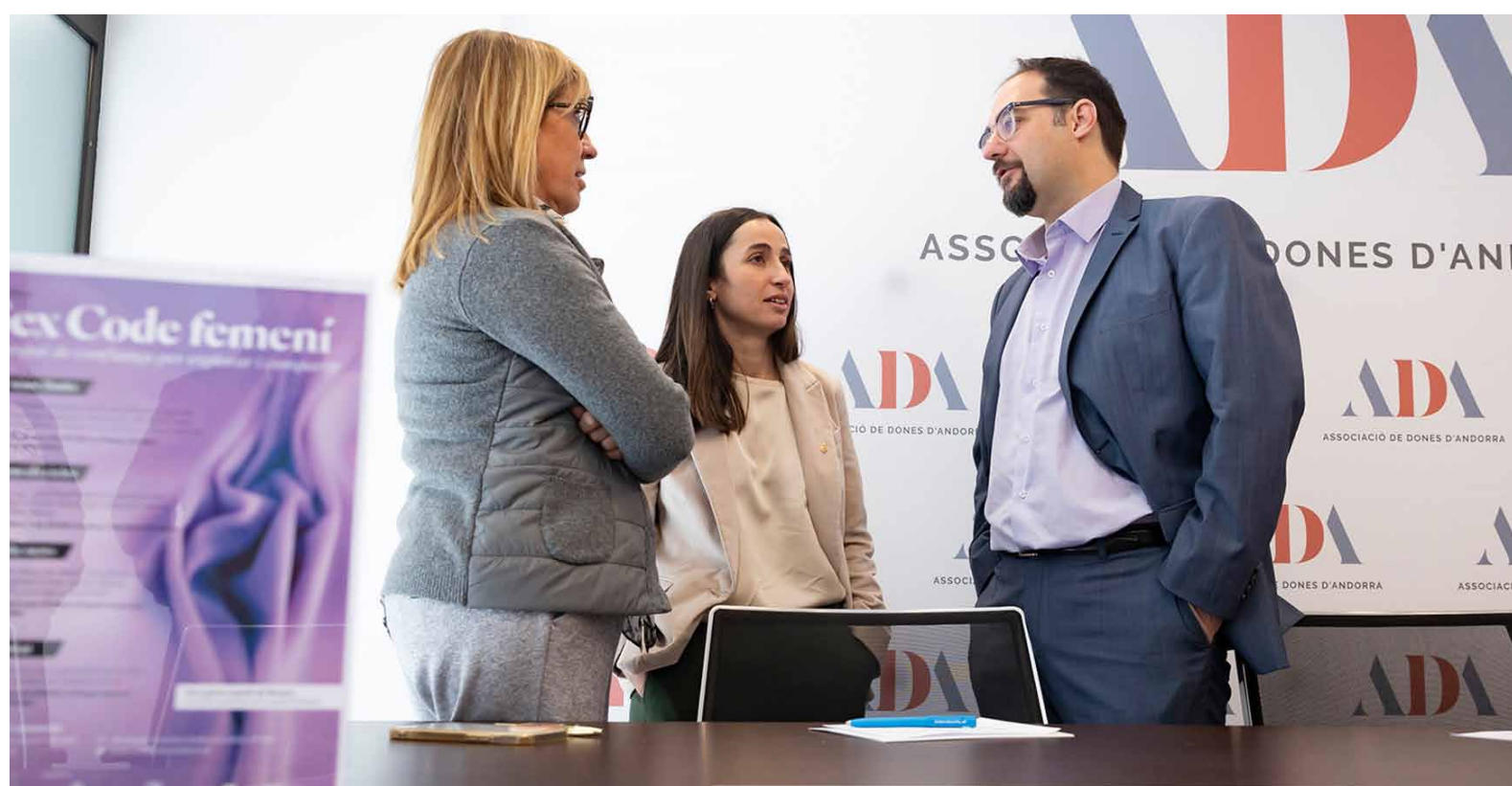


REACTIONS OF THE ENTITIES TO THE GOVERNMENT'S ORDER

Codina and Pallarés support the legal study on online erotic content

The two spokespeople highlight the vulnerability it leaves its creators when it leads to abuse

The most popular parliamentary question this past week came from the general councilor of Concòrdia, Núria Segués, who opened a certainly controversial debate with the Minister of Justice and Interior, Ester Molné, on whether the disclosure and exposure of the female body on the Internet could be considered a practice comparable to conventional prostitution. In this sense, the head of the judicial portfolio asserted that the Executive has already commissioned a legal study to determine the nature of this online content and to know whet-

her its legal framework should be modified, and its disclosure and creation should be restricted and sanctioned. Thus, two national organizations with power and strength such as the Andorran Women's Association, headed by Mònica Codina, and the Andorran Women's Institute, chaired by Judith Pallarés, have discussed the issue with EL PERIÒDIC.

«Technologies, together with society, evolve, and have managed to find new ways to leave women in a position of commodity and vulnerability. That is why the Government's decision is in the right direction since the laws need to be modernized and adapted accordingly,»

the president of the ADA exclaimed on the issue. Specifically, she emphasizes that these platforms that have become popular today to promote erotic content such as OnlyFans or Sugar Baby «have proven to become mechanisms for cyber prostitution.»

Continuing the line, the spokesperson for the feminist entity believes that prostitution has evolved in our times «in a way that it is no longer necessary to maintain physical contact to consummate itself», disclosing at the same time that the clients and consumers of this content are giving full support to «an unpleasant fact». That is why she believes that the

Government's initiative to contemplate its regulation «goes in the right direction».

For her part, the president of the IAD also adds that the possible change in the legislative framework «is a good proposal», despite warning of the complexity it entails: «I do not know exactly how the Executive will approach the issue, but I have been summoned soon to Minister Molné to give her our point of view. It will be necessary to legally draw up its legal framework before deciding on possible sanctions. In our opinion, these networks are a form of aggression towards women and with a monetary exchange in between», she states. Pallarés also finds that girls who expose themselves in these places «are more vulnerable, since subsequent steps can trigger significant processes of violence, remembering that this activity does not provide any value». ●

The weather warning activated over the weekend in the Port d'Envalira or the CG3 at the height of the Serrat have been withdrawn

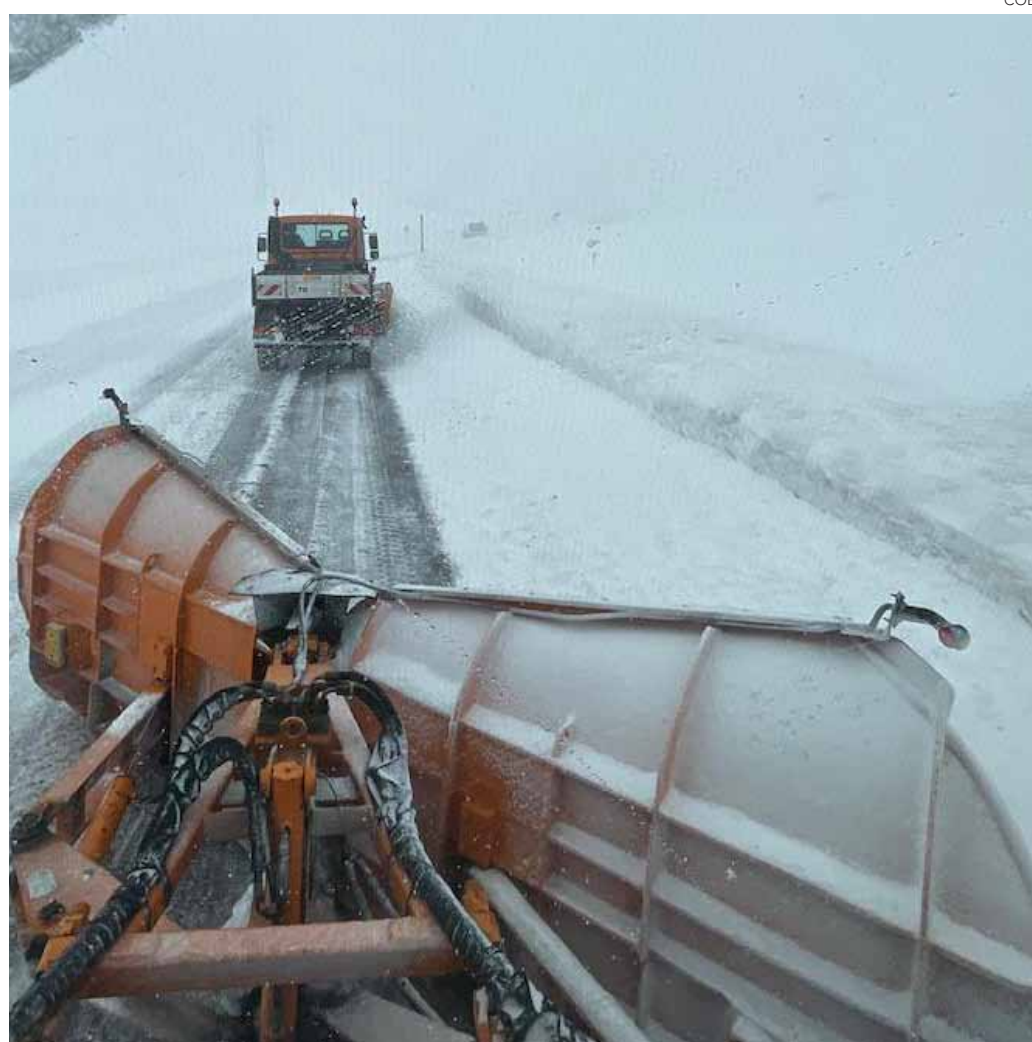

Little by little, normality is returning to the roads and the entire road network of the Principality. The adverse weather conditions experienced over the weekend caused some restrictions on the country's roads, or even their closure. The heavy snowfall and winds that were recorded forced the closure of roads such as the CG4 to access the Port de Cabús, the RN320 through the Puymorens pass or the CG2 in the Port d'Envalira because «there is a danger of being immobilized on the road for long periods of time», the Mobility service reported on Saturday.

So, the only vehicles that could circulate through the Port d'Envalira were those with winter viability and service vehicles. That is why the Conservation and Exploitation of Andorran Roads (COEX) were working all day with their teams to reopen them, reports the ANA.

This Sunday the situation has improved, since this mor-

ning only the CG4 to access the Port de Cabús remains closed, as Mobility highlights on its networks. At this point, Mobility has announced that the black and yellow phase has been en-

ded throughout the Principality and its accesses.

On the other hand, the Ordino Arcalís ski resort was able to resume its activity this Sunday after it was unable to do so on Sa-

turday due to strong winds, caused by the snowfall that fell and poor visibility due to the presence of fog. Given these conditions, those responsible for the facility chose not to open the ski area because «it is not allowed to operate normally and with the required safety», they claimed from the station.

cal Service reported today that the passage of the front left strong gusts of wind, leaving some points of the country where they exceeded 100 km/hour, as is the case in Envalira, which was 103.3; in Les Salines, with 102.5; or in Borda Vidal, with 102.6 Km/h. Also noteworthy is the strong wind that blew in Roc de Sant Pere with a figure of 87.8.●
